AS FRESHMEN IN THE CANR AT MSU**

Purpose:

The Michigan FFA Alumni recognizes the need to encourage and assist FFA members in setting and meeting goals related to education and career development. The College of Agriculture and Natural Resources (CANR) and the College of Veterinary Medicine at Michigan State University (MSU) provides the necessary facilities, resources, and programs to meet the educational and career development needs of students. The Michigan FFA Alumni, CANR and College of Veterinary Medicine are participating in a matching scholarship program designed to help and assist FFA members in achieving their goals while attending the College of Agriculture and Natural Resources at MSU or College of Veterinary Medicine at MSU.

Eligibility:

1. Scholarship applicants must be FFA members.
2. Applicants must be accepted by MSU and be enrolled in the College of Agriculture and Natural Resources or the College of Veterinary Medicine as freshmen.
3. Applicants must apply according to Michigan State University and FFA Alumni rules, instructions and application forms.
4. Scholarship awards are only for the freshmen year.
5. Applicants must be from a chapter that has an active FFA Alumni Chapter.
