#### **Dues Structure**

- Annual Member
  - \$10 per year plus applicable state and local dues
  - Annual memberships are per individual
- Collegiate Member
  - \$5 per year plus applicable state and local dues
  - Only valid for current Collegiate FFA Members
- Life Member
  - One Time Payment of \$150 plus applicable state and local dues
  - Life memberships are per individual
